ADMISSION OF STUDENTS IN HOSTING SITUATIONS AT UQAT

Health insurance and hospitalisation for students, interns, as well as postdoctoral foreign interns and those coming from a university outside of Canada (Case # 2-4 et 5)

Upon their arrival, foreign students coming from countries that are not eligible for the Quebec Health Insurance Plan (RAMQ) will have to, at their own cost, mandatorily subscribe to a health and hospitalisation insurance at the International Students' Office, **except postdoctoral interns.**

Intergovernmental agreements regarding social insurance have been signed between **Québec and Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Greece, Luxembourg, Norway, Portugal and Sweden.** These agreements allow for free coverage from the Quebec Health Insurance Plan (RAMQ). This protection excludes dental costs, eye exams, glasses and medication, except for the cases of Belgium and France, where medication is covered. To avail yourself of this coverage, you need to get a form, and have it filled out by your country's Social Insurance before coming to Quebec.

French students waiting to be accepted in a graduate or postgraduate programme (Case #2) (including Guadeloupe, Reunion Island, Martinique and French Guyana) will have to have the form SE-401Q-102 in hand and completed by their Social Insurance in France before their departure. Without it the cost of the health and hospitalisation insurance will be imposed upon them.

French internship students (Case #4) (including Guadeloupe, Reunion Island, Martinique and French Guyana) will have to have the form SE-401Q-102 in hand and completed by their Social Insurance in France before their departure, without it the cost of the health and hospitalisation insurance will be imposed upon them.

Postdoctoral internship students (Case #5) do not need to provide proof of health insurance coverage. It is, however, highly recommended to avail yourself of this coverage, you need to get a form, and have it filled out by your country's Social Insurance before coming to Quebec.

The procedure to obtain the RAMQ card will be sent to you upon your arrival, when you will present your mandatory documents package to the Foreign Students' Service Counsellor at the **International Students' Office room C-124.**
